



Richmond Law Moot Court Competition

This semester's moot problem is about First Amendment journalistic privilege and a government subpoena for the identity of a journalist's source in a federal criminal Hobbs Act case. Volunteer judges will get to pose challenging questions to students during their oral arguments and provide feedback to the competitors afterwards. We also invite volunteers to dine with us and the competitors between rounds; this gives us the chance to thank them with a meal and the students a chance to meet attorneys in the area.

Our rounds of competition are scheduled as follows – we have openings for judges for all rounds, but we are on particular need on March 29th and April 4th, bolded below:

Round 1: Friday, March 29th 6:00 PM Session; 8:00 PM Session;

Round 2: Monday, April 1st 6:00 PM Session; 8:00 PM Session;

Round 3: Tuesday, April 2nd 6:00 PM Session; 8:00 PM Session;

Quarterfinals: Thursday, April 4th 6:00 PM; and

Semifinals: Monday, April 8th 6:00 PM.
